Who are Youth Hubs for?



Youth Hubs are for young people aged 10–18 who live or go to school in Everton and Anfield, who have a interest in learning about music or creating new sounds with other young people.

When and where are they?

Youth Hubs meet weekly during term time. We hold hubs on a Tuesday and Thursday evening between 4:00 – 6:30pm.



No prior experience of playing any instrument is required! Just tell us what you'd like to try and we'll make sure you have an instrument and support from one of our professional musicians.

I don't play an instrument can I still attend?

Do I need to bring my own instrument ?

No we provide an instrument to all Youth Hub members, but if you already have your own you're welcome to bring that too. We offer lessons on;

- Strings: Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass
- Wind: Oboe, Flute, Clarinet, Bassoon
- Brass: Cornet, Trumpet, Baritone, Euphonium, Trombone, Tuba
- Percussion: Orchestral Percussion, Drum Kit

- A chance to relax and socialise with friends
- Practice their instrument or do homework
- find and join music ensembles which are the right fit for them
- create new music
- take part in creative and employability sessions about future careers in the music
