

MATHS – YEAR 9 SCHOLARS

This half term our year 9 scholars students further developed their understanding of mathematics by teaching it to others. In order to do this we took them back to where their love of maths began, their primary schools. Our scholars delivered engaging and exciting maths sessions at Our Lady Immaculate, Gwladys Street and Learnington.



ART – SKILL SHARE

SCIENCE – PRACTICAL SESSIONS

COMPUTING – LEGO ROBOTICS

The computing department loved delivering Lego robotics to our year 5 scholars this term. The students constructed a Beaufort scale wind indicator. They then programmed their device to display the wind speed from different cities around the world using quantitative cloud data. The computing department also visited Learnington to deliver Lego Robotics and loved seeing the students problem solving skills develop throughout the afternoon.
